- Multilinguality is an opportunity!
  - Multilingual online markets
  - Translation
- Think Big!
  - Big data
  - Big semantics (facts, knowledge)
- Content
  - Search : fast and accurate, cross-lingual
  - Management of growing organizations
  - Analysis of transcribed texts
  - Making sense of unstructured content
  - Analytics

## **Inhibitors**



#### Lack of resources inhibitor:

- Availability of linguistic resources
  - Development and maintenance costs for each new language
- Multilingual sources of information
  - some information are locked in few languages

#### Lack of data inhibitor:

Specialized data with large coverage

#### Business inhibitors:

- Do-nothing strategy
- Too small actors

### Technological inhibitors:

- Scalable and real time LT
- No common set of APIs
- Languages difficulties (synonymy, polysemy)
